### Phone Survey Results

**The Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport (ANC) Master Plan Update team has conducted a phone survey and the results are in!**

In addition to regular outreach tools such as public meetings and informational flyers, the Anchorage Airport Master Plan Update team is making an extra effort to reach the public regarding this project because of its value to all Anchorage residents.

Three of the top findings from the phone survey include:

1. Eighty-one percent (81%) of study respondents rank the Airport as *very important* to the local economy.
2. Most residents of Anchorage desire that the Airport grow at its current location; eighty percent (80%) of those in the survey support growth acquiring land as necessary in the current location.
3. Anchorage residents use the many parks and recreation areas in West Anchorage that are located on and near Airport property. Sixty percent (60%) of survey respondents said they use the Coastal Trail around Point Woronzof.
